Biographical History¹

John Simon (Cape Town, 1944) studied composition at Trinity College of Music and the Royal College of Music, London, where his teachers included James Patten and John Lambert. His works have been widely performed and broadcast in South Africa (many performances with the Cape Town Symphony Orchestra, National Symphony Orchestra of the SABC, Cape Town Philharmonic Orchestra, Cape Philharmonic Orchestra, National Arts Orchestra of Pretoria, Kwa-Zulu Natal Philharmonic Orchestra, Capab Orchestra and University of Stellenbosch Orchestra) as well as performances and broadcasts of his work in the UK and Europe. His UK activities have included significant work with the BBC. He has written extensively for piano -an area of his work that has been neglected in recent years in favour of other types of composition- having five piano sonatas to his credit. His orchestral output includes a Symphony, two Piano Concertos, a Violin Concerto (BBC premiere), a 'Requiem for Orchestra' (BBC premiere with Sir Edward Downes, the work having been recommended to the BBC by Sir Simon Rattle), the symphonic suite 'Children of the Sun' (premiered by the CTSO under Omri Hadari in 1992) and the much broadcast orchestral song cycle 'Portrait of Emily' - settings of Emily Dickinson for soprano and orchestra (first sung by Andrea Catzel).

A number of his more important works were written in response to the situation that prevailed in South Africa during the apartheid years. As a consequence Threnody 2 for strings, clarinet and timpani, which was composed in 1981 and dedicated to Steve Biko, was under embargo at the SABC until as late as 1993 (it was the first work ever to include the South African national anthem as a theme). Threnody 2 has since been widely broadcast and performed, including performances at the Edinburgh International Festival in 1998.

His vocal works include settings of John Masefield, Wilfred Owen, Shelley and Byron. He has written an a cappella choral work - a setting of Matthew Arnold's 'Dover Beach'.

John Simon was until 2005 Composer in Residence to the KwaZulu-Natal Phiharmonic Orchestra (the first such appointment in South Africa) and lecturer in orchestration at the University of KwaZulu-Natal's School of Music. He was charged with the KZNPO's New Music Initiative, which had the aim of bringing orchestral skills to KwaZulu-Natal-based composers and arrangers.

He was most recently engaged in orchestrating 'Zizi Lethu' ('Our Hope') by the KZN composer Phelelani Mnomiya. These orchestral realisations featured in the KZN Philharmonic's joint London concert schedule with the London Symphony Orchestra at the Barbican, and elsewhere in the UK and Europe (November 2004), and led to a new composition of his own for concert orchestra entitled 'Dance to Freedom' premiered at the Cape Town International Festival in November 2007. His most recent work is entitled 'A Peal of Bells', written for string orchestra, tubular bells and celesta, together with an alternative version for cello and piano.
