

Obtain off-campus electronic access

For off-campus access to the library's e-resources via the <u>library homepage</u>, you need to be enrolled as a network registered undergraduate-, post graduate student or prospective postgraduate student or staff member of the University of Stellenbosch.

When off-campus and prompted with the off-campus logon screen, log on with your network Username and Password. Once logged in, you will have full access to all the electronic resources the library subscribes to.


How to get access to E-References for example electronic dictionaries and electronic encyclopedias



E-Reference: Gale Virtual Reference Library




How to get access to E-References for electronic dictionaries and Educational e-reference sources




What is Boolean logic


Boolean logic consists of three logical operators: OR AND NOT



Information Literacy AND Academic Literacy



Information Literacy OR Academic Literacy



Information Literacy NOT Academic Literacy

AND

 Articles will contain both Information Literacy AND Academic Literacy

OR

 Articles will contain either Information Literacy OR Academic Literacy

NOT

 Articles will contain Information Literacy but not Academic Literacy

Search String Tools

Identify the *concepts* in your search

Use "AND" to combine search terms (less hits)

Use "OR" for synonyms (more hits)

Use "NOT" to narrows your search by excluding entire categories or information

Use the * (asterix) for truncation

Example: "south* africa*" will include all these words:

South Africa

Southern Africa

Southern African

South Africans

Research Commons

A space where academic staff, masters and doctoral students can do research, collaborate and get library support.

Auditorium

A lecture hall with seating for 147 people, equipped with inter alia an overhead projector, and computer with USB & CD/DVDdrives. Bookings should be made at the Lending Section: tel: 021-808 4883 or e-mail: jsg_util@sun.ac.za.

Distribution shelves

Returned material is placed here before shelving.

Compact storage

A large storage area for newspapers and discontinued and cancelled journal titles. Enquiries for these items are handled by staff members at the service desk of the compact storage area, Monday - Friday 08:00 - 16:30 and after hours at the Short Loans Section (upper level).


De Necker training room

Main entrance

Access to the Library is subject to identification by SU card or ID document.

Lending section

Issues, renewals, reservations and room bookings. A self-check-out system opposite this section allows you to check out books by yourself.

Short loans section

Frequently used materials is made available here for use of short periods in the Library only. These include reserved journals and audiovisual material. Shelves are arranged alphabetically according to academic department and lecturer.

Distribution shelves

Storing place for returned material preliminary to shelving.

RMS Photocopying & Scanning

For photocopying, scanning and colour printing.

Interlending

Material not available at SU libraries may be requested from Southern African or international institutions.

Reading area

Includes leasure reading books, daily newspapers and a weekly display of new books that can be reserved at the Lending section.

Learning Commons

A learning space for students, with computers, discussion booths, a help desk and a training room.

F-classroom

For the presentation of information literacy programmes.

Information technology (IT) section

Specialised assistance with regards to information technology enquiries.

Special collections

Acquisition and preservation of rare materials for posterity. The section consists of three sub-sections namely Manuscripts, Africana and Rare Books.


Wireless access


All electronic devices (e.g. laptops, mobile phones, iPads or tablets), registered with the IT Hub, will have wireless access to the campus network in the Library.








Search SUNSearch for e-books

Electronic books are the digital equivalent of hard copy books.

Some of the e-books and e-book websites only allow access to a limited number of SU members at the same time. You will get a message that the book is not available and you will have to try again later.

On most, but not all, clients can create a free, individual account which will allow the reader to:

- •save books to a personal bookshelf from where it can be accessed again at a later stage
- highlight sections and insert notes
- print individual pages
