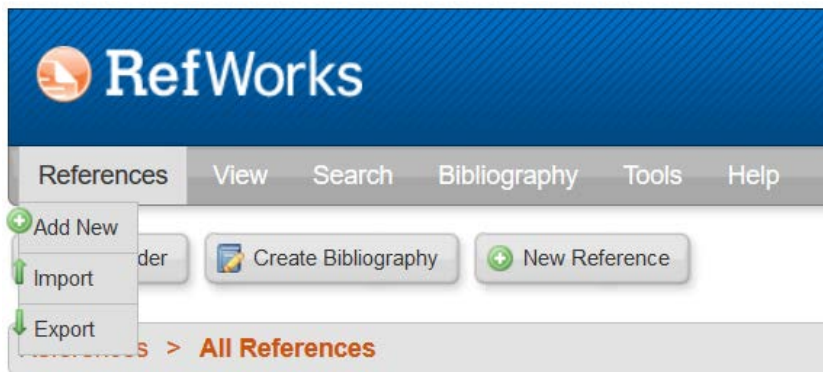


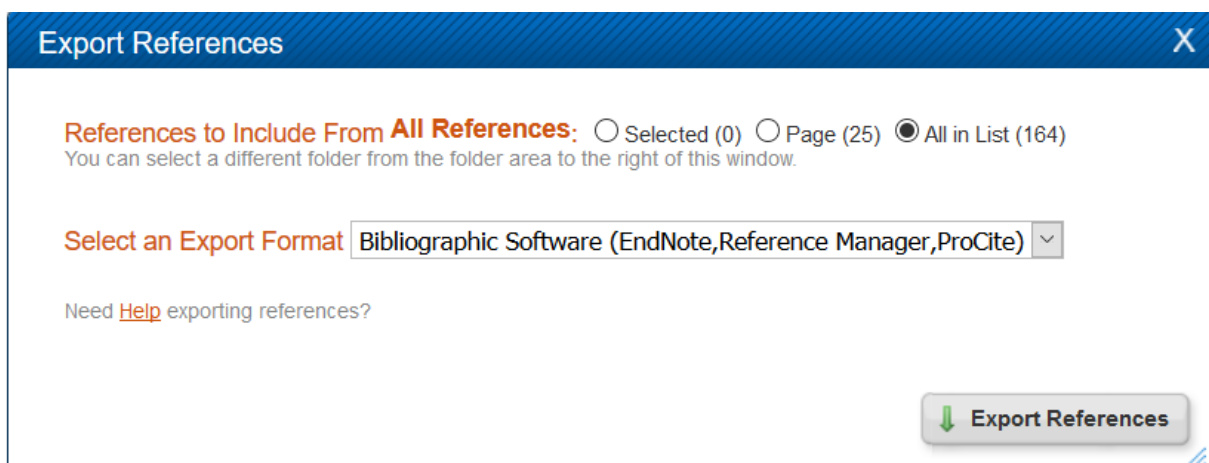
Migrating from RefWorks to Mendeley

1. If you do not have a Mendeley Account, create an account at www.mendeley.com. Download Mendeley Desktop.

Login into Refworks, then click on **References>Export**



2. You can export all of your citations from Refworks as a whole or export by folder. To export your entire library of citations, make sure you are in “All References” view. If you are not, click on the “References” link. Then click on export in the menu on the right side of the page under “Quick Access”. A box will appear asking you which references you wish to include and what format you would like to export your citations in. Click “All in List” and select the format “Bibliographic software: Endnote, Reference Manager, ProCite” and click “Export References”.



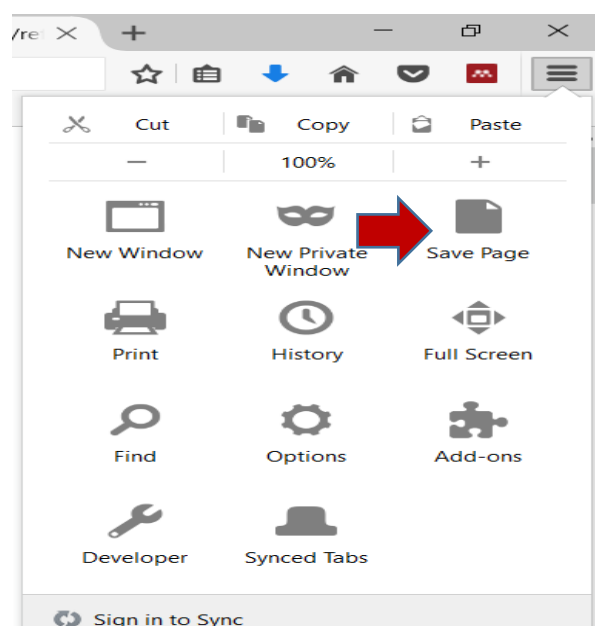
3. A new window or tab will open in your web browser, displaying your references. Go to the browser file menu and select File> Save Page As (In Internet Explorer, Save as...) **See below.**

If you are exporting all of your references, you do not need to change the name of the TXT file being saved. If you are exporting one folder at a time to preserve your folder structure, then rename the file with same name as the folder being exported.

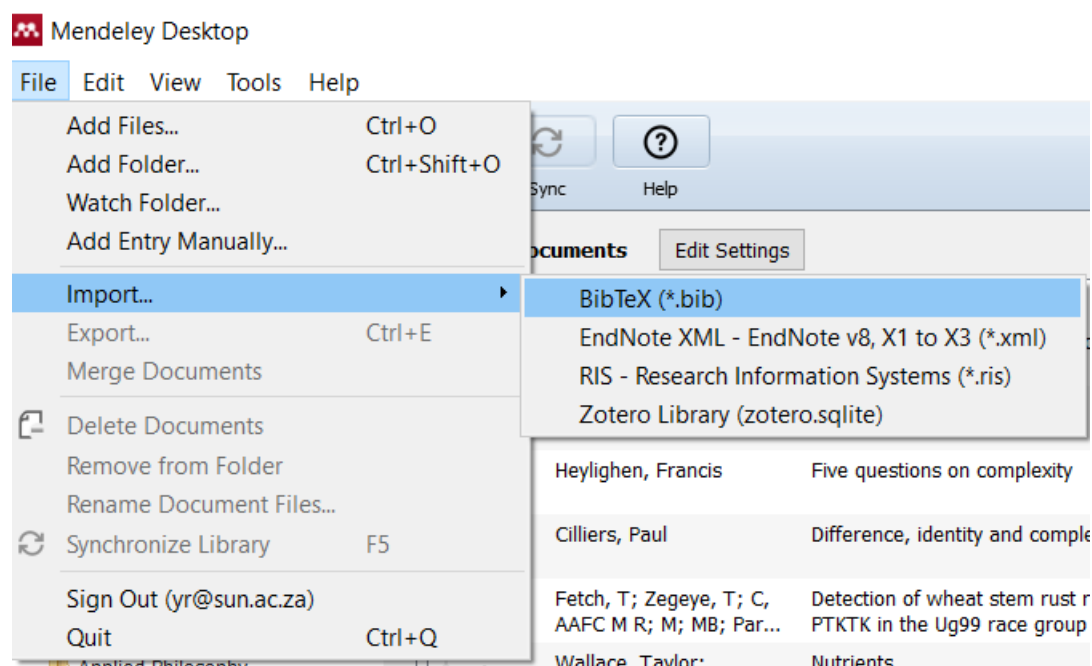

4. Open Mendeley Desktop

Go to File > Import > BibTeX (*.bib)

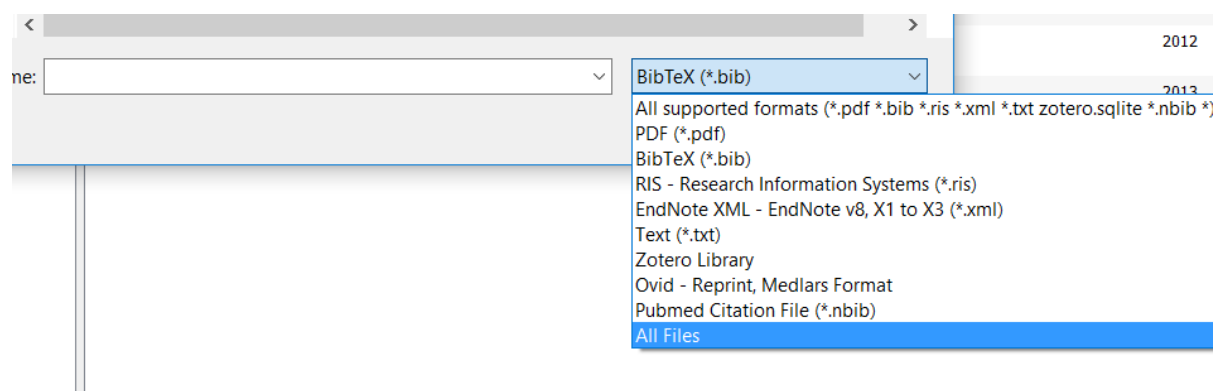


5. Change setting to ALL Files >

Locate the file you exported from RefWorks

Mendeley should import all the references automatically.

Your items will be imported, then you can arrange them in your Mendeley library as you see fit.



Please bear in mind that this process will ONLY add the references to your Mendeley Desktop. To add the PDF from RefWorks to Mendeley you will need to download them manually and add them to your Mendeley Desktop.
